Time: Governors Championship: 9:00AM (Relay 1 Saturday, Relay 2 Sunday.)
CMP EIC and NRA DR match: 3:00PM both days, multiple relays if necessary.

Location: Tacoma Rifle and Revolver Club

University Place, WA 98467

Directions: Find your way to Bridgeport Way West from one of the major highways. Then make your way either north or southbound on Bridgeport until you reach Chambers Lane West. Turn right/left at this "T" intersection and head westbound towards Chambers Bay Golf Course. Chambers Lane will turn into Chambers Creek Road. Go past Charles Wright Academy (on your right). When you reach the Danbridge housing community start looking for the TRRC sign and gate. It is about 100 feet on the right. Gate is powered with coded member's keycard access. Non-members, push the black button for entry.

Lodging/Food: Camping is allowed at the range with prior arrangements. There is no food service at the range.

Eligibility: This is a Washington State Rifle & Pistol Association sanctioned state championship. WSRPA membership or resident state association (for out of state shooters) membership is required. WSRPA membership applications will be available at the match. NRA membership is not required. CMP match eligibility is per CMP competition rules.

Entry Fees: 2700 point Governor's-20 Championship/State Leg: \$35.00
CMP Excellence-in-Competition Match: \$10.00
NRA Distinguished Revolver Match: included with 2700; \$5.00 if stand alone

Entries: Advance entries are requested. Post entries will be accepted until the first relay begins. The match will be limited to 22 competitors each relay. Competitors may fire both relays if firing points are available, but only the first relay's score will be eligible for awards. Fees are payable the day of the match. Squadding: All Matches will be squadded. Squadding Tickets may be picked up at the Stat Office between 8:30 AM and 9:00 AM the day of the match.

Scoring: Target repairs and scoring is competitor's responsibility. A returnable fee of \$1.00 posted on challenges.

- Awards:**
1. Normal awards for first place will be made if class has 3 competitors. Second place awards will be made in classes having 6 or more entries. There must be three competitors in any class to receive awards; less than three, competitors will compete in the next higher class.
 2. Washington State Rifle and Pistol Association (WSRPA) Medals will be awarded to the top two competitors in each class, regardless of the number of competitors in that class.
 3. The top 10 competitors will receive certificates signed by The Governor.
