### When are the classes held?

**Schedule for 2008.** This is a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and then Saturday Field Exercise Day scenario. The Adult Paradigm Class is the exception.

**March** 10,11,12,14 evening 6:30 – 9:30 pm  
Live Fire. This is a traditional course.

Saturday August 9<sup>th</sup> 8:30 am - 4:00 pm Field Course and Live

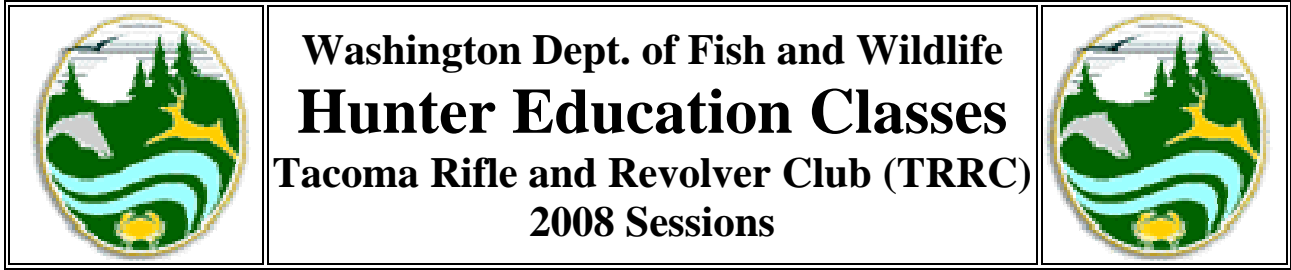
**Adults Only Class** evening of **June 13** 6:00 pm - 9:30pm Saturday June 14<sup>th</sup> Field course 8:30-4:00 pm and Live Fire. This course is recommended for **Adults Only**. It is an abbreviated course named **Paradigm Shift**. This is a compressed class which places the entire burden for learning on the student, this hunter education activity is only recommended for adult students. No formal instruction is presented. The class meets on a Friday evening to conduct a brief review and take the written test. Upon satisfactory completion of the written test, the student is invited to attend the Field Exercise and Live Fire event which is usually conducted the following Saturday at our range facility. This is Paradigm Shift class where no formal instruction is presented. All preparation is the responsibility of the person attending. A written examination must be successfully completed unless an online certificate is presented.

**\*Traditional classes are 15 + hours, 5 days and usually limited to 24 students.  
Students must attend all 15 hours to graduate.**

### **What is Hunter Education?**

Hunter Education is part of the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW). If prospective hunters were born on or after January 1, 1972, you must attend and pass a Hunter Education Class to get your hunting license. We welcome students of any age. But be aware that the student must be “big” enough to safely carry an adult size firearm on our field course. If this sounds like something you might be interested in, please refer to the bottom of this flyer for registration information. Students 12 years old and younger **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or guardian during course instruction.

### **Where are classes held?**

We conduct our classroom instruction at the American Legion Doughboy Memorial Post 138, which is located at 7515 Cirque Drive, West, in University Place. The telephone number at that facility is 253-460-1105. These classes are conducted on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 6:30 PM thru 9:30 PM and again on Friday from 6:30 PM thru about 9:00 PM. The Field Exercise and Live Fire are held at the Tacoma Rifle and Revolver Club (TRRC) range facilities located at 8503 Chambers Creek Road, West, in University Place beginning at 8:30 AM the following Saturday. Ancillary classes like first aid and survival are taught on Saturday. Optional classes on field dressing game may also be presented.

### **How much does it cost?**

The class and instruction are free. There is a deposit of \$25 required to hold your place in class. The deposit will be refunded at graduation. Your check payable to TRRC Hunter Education must be sent to the following address to complete the enrollment process:

### **General Information for parents of students:**

Each student is required to purchase and wear during class an International Orange vest of sufficient size to conform to state regulations (400 square inches of colored material). These are relatively inexpensive. Be sure to consider size over winter clothing when purchasing. Additionally, we require each student to possess and wear a survival backpack. It is not necessary to fill the backpack (school book backpack is very acceptable) with unneeded items. Don't spend a large amount of money. Suggest you wait until the survival class to determine what items you might want to purchase. Having said that, a compass, something for warmth, something to keep dry, and non-perishable food items are all good to begin to think about.

Parents must keep in mind the maturity level of the student, his/her physical ability to perform hunting tasks, and the general attitude toward hunting.

**Students must be physically able to safely discharge a rifle, shotgun, and a handgun and will be required to do so to successfully complete the class.** All participants must have eye and ear protection on the day of live firing. Ammunition and firearms are provided. No live ammunition may be brought into the classroom except by certified instructors.
